Operating Steps

How to share a device?

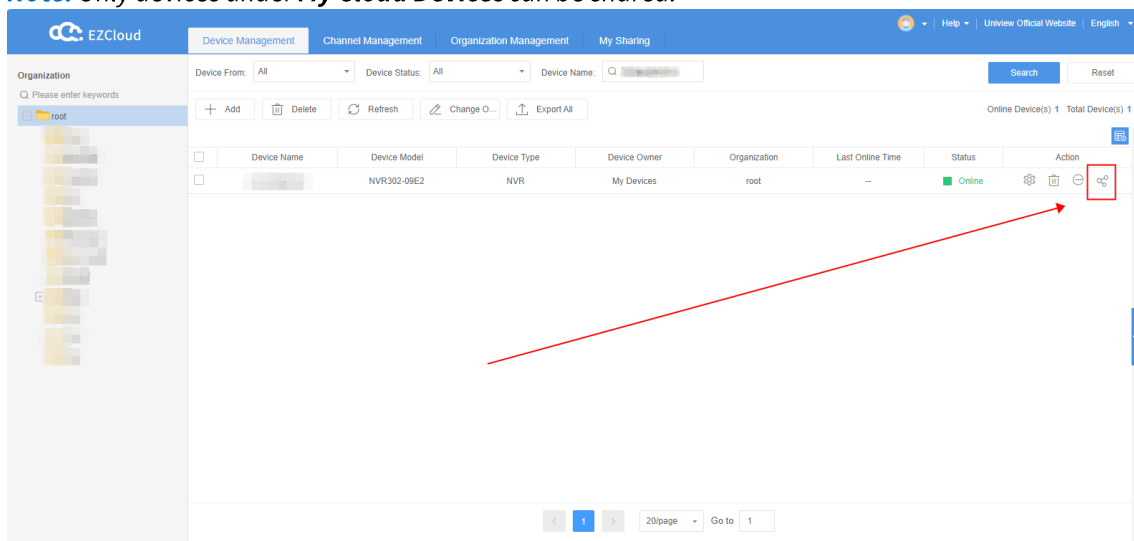
Note: Different users can also login to the same account on different cellphones to view devices on that account.

Method 1 Share from EZCloud website

Step 1 Log into the EZCloud website <https://global.ezcloud.uniview.com/login>

Go to **Device management>My Cloud Devices**. Click  on the operation column.

Note: Only devices under **My Cloud Devices** can be shared.



Step 2 Enter the other user's EZCloud account (username/email address) to complete the sharing.

Permissions: Admin is the default user with full operation permissions. You can also share a device to a user with limited permissions (It is required to add that user on the device's web or GUI first).

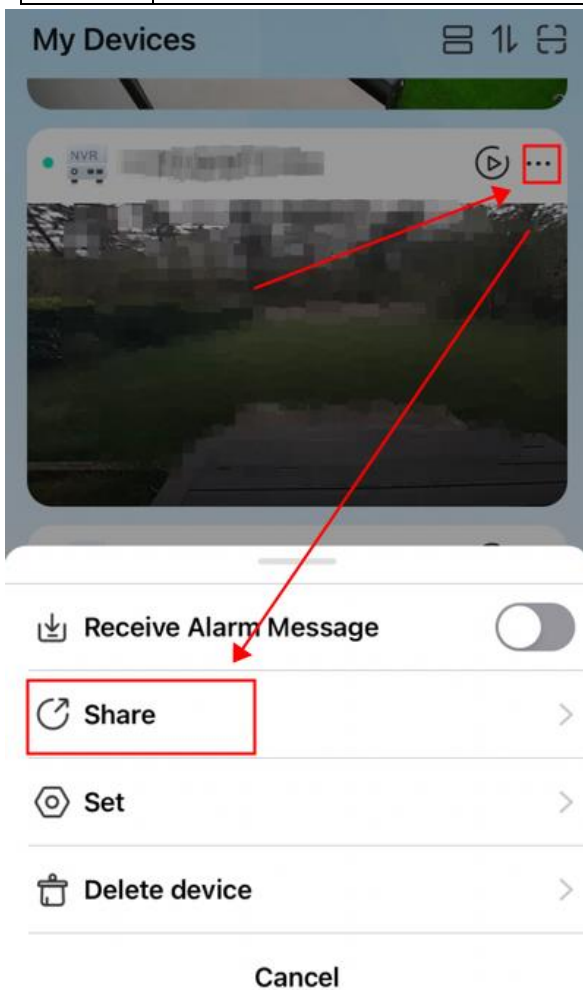
Note:

Method 2 Share from UNV-Link

Step 1 Log into your UNV-Link and go to the devices page. Click • • • on the device you want to share, and click **Share**.

Step 2 Enter the email/username/phone number of the user you wish to share the device with and set up the valid period, select permissions you want the user to have.

Note: Devices shared by Function can only be viewed on the app. They will not show on EZStation when you log in the cloud account.

Method 2 Cancel the Sharing from UNV-Link

Step 1 Log into your UNV-Link and go to **Me**.

Step 2 Click on **Sharing Management**, select the sharing record and click **Stop Sharing** to cancel sharing.
